### From Chicago:

From downtown Chicago, the drive will take you approximately 60-70 minutes. Take the Edens (94 West) to the toll way (94 North) toward Milwaukee. Follow 94 West/North approximately 6 miles beyond Great America. Exit at 173/Rosecrans Road. At the stop sign on the off-ramp, turn left onto Rosecrans. Go ½ mile to the first intersecting street, Hunt Club Road. Turn right on Hunt Club. Go exactly 2 miles to the first stop sign. Turn left onto Stateline Road. Proceed west and turn right onto MB (152nd Avenue). Follow signs to riders' entrance.

### From Milwaukee:

Take 94 East (South) several exits south of Wisconsin Hwy. 50 to the Hwy. 165 exit (Exit 347). At the end of the off-ramp turn right. Go 1 mile to County U. Turn left on County U. Follow County U 2 miles to the first stop sign and turn right onto Stateline Road. Proceed west and turn onto MB (152nd Avenue). Follow signs to riders' entrance.

### From the West:

From Highway 45 turn east onto State Line Road (County Road WG or 128th Street) proceed apx. 2 miles. Turn left onto MB (152nd Avenue). Follow signs to riders' entrance.

A training period in the main arena with a course consisting of approximately eight obstacles including a combination, 1.40m to 1.45m in height, 1.50m in width. Each competitor is permitted a maximum of 90 seconds per horse.

Declarations to compete must be made no later than 9:00 a.m. Friday, September 10th. Declarations received after 9:00 a.m. September 10th will be accepted at managements' discretion.

Dress is informal; boots, breeches, shirt and a hard hat must be worn.

### **Class 2 – \$25,000 THE CAVALOR SHOW JUMPING HALL OF FAME JUNIOR/ AMATEUR OWNER CLASSIC**

#### **TIME FIRST JUMP-OFF - Table II, Sec. 2(a)**

Fences up 1.45 m in height, 1.50m in width - speed 375 m/min.

Open to approximately 30 Junior and Amateur Owner riders, entries based on winnings using USEF Money Won Records during the qualifying period at shows starting on or after August 17th, 2009 through shows starting on or before August 16th, 2010. Money won outside of the U.S. must be on record and confirmed by the USEF. Evergreen Management reserves the right to invite up to two riders as "wildcards"

Declarations to compete must be made no later than 5:00 p.m. Friday, September 10th. Declarations received after 5:00 p.m. September 10th will be accepted at managements' discretion.

Only running martingales, used in the conventional manner, are permitted.

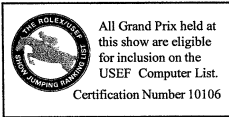

If at the closing of entries, August 23, 2010, there are less than 30 entries, selected riders, based on the ROLEX/USEF Computer list dated August 13th, 2010, will be permitted to enter a third horse until the number of entries reaches 30. If after using the procedure described the number of entries has not reached 30, post entries will be accepted on a first come first served bases.

### Federation Entry Agreement

I have read the United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") Entry Agreement (GR906.4) as printed in the Prize List for this Competition and agree to all of its provisions. I understand and agree that by entering this Competition, I am subject to Federation Rules, Prize List, and local rules of the competition. I agree to waive the right to the use of my photos at the competition, and agree that any actions against the Federation must be brought in New York State.

### Federation Release, Assumption of Risk, Waiver and Indemnification

This document waives important legal rights. Read it carefully before signing.

I AGREE in consideration for my participation in this Competition [Evergreen Invitational] to the following:

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in the Competition with my horse, as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, or as a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports and the Competition involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss, and serious bodily injury including broken bones, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering, or death ("Harm").

I AGREE to release the Federation and the Competition from all claims for money damages or otherwise for any Harm to me or my horse and for any Harm caused by me or my horse to others, even if the Harm resulted, directly, or indirectly, from the negligence of the Federation or the Competition.

I AGREE to expressly assume all risks of Harm to me or my horse, including Harm resulting from the negligence of the Federation or the Competition.

I AGREE to indemnify (that is, to pay any losses, damages, or costs incurred by) the Federation and the Competition and to hold them harmless with respect to claims for Harm to me or my horse, and for claims made by others for any Harm caused by me or my horse at the Competition. I have read the Federation Rules about protective equipment, including GR801 and EV114, and I understood that I am entitled to wear protective equipment without penalty, and I acknowledge that the Federation strongly encourages me to do so while WARNING that no protective equipment can guard against all injuries.

If I am a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, I consent to the child's participation and AGREE to assume all of the obligations of this Release on the child's behalf.

I AGREE that "the Federation" and "Competition" as used above includes all of the officials, officers, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers and affiliated organizations.

I AGREE that if I am injured at this competition, the medical personnel treating my injuries may provide information on my injury and treatment to the Federation on the official USEF accident/injury report form.

I represent that I have the requisite training, coaching and abilities to safely compete in this competition.

BY SIGNING I AGREE to be bound by all applicable Federation Rules and all terms and provisions of this entry blank.

# EVERGREEN INVITATIONAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN, WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULE BOOK, WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.

Complete entry blank enclosed, including all USEF numbers and signatures required.

ONE HORSE PER ENTRY BLANK. Additional entry blanks may be obtained from our website, [www.EvergreenInvitational.org](http://www.EvergreenInvitational.org), or by calling: Kate Galdi at 847-224-3854.

Every exhibitor must furnish his/her social security or Federal I.D. number.

The Committee reserves the right of declining to receive any entry, and to return any entry fees before or during the Show, without being held liable for compensation.

Junior and Amateur Owner Jumper entries accepted are based on winnings, and will use USEF Money Won Records to qualify during the qualifying period at shows starting on or after August 17, 2009 through shows starting on or before August 16, 2010. Money won outside the U.S. must be on record with and confirmed by USEF. Two riders may be selected as wildcards, at the discretion of management.

Open Jumper riders will qualify based on their ranking on the USEF Computer List dated August 13, 2010. Two riders may be selected as wildcards, at the discretion of management.

All Jumpers must be on the grounds by 9:00 AM, Friday, September 10th.

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 nonmember registration fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

## **FEES**

Payment of all fees must be made in U.S. funds. A penalty of \$50.00 will be charged for all nonnegotiable funds. Management reserves the right to prohibit from competition and return the entry of any owner, rider, driver or trainer whose processing or entry fee payment has been returned as non-negotiable on one or more occasions. The horse show reserves the right to require guaranteed funds from exhibitors.

## **ADDITIONAL RULES**

Numbers, provided by the Horse Show, must be worn when entering the Show Ring. GR 801.9 will not be enforced. Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the Judges or Officials on the part of any owner, rider, driver, trainer or groom may disqualify the horse, and the owner may forfeit all entry and other fees.

### **ARENA SIZE AND FOOTING**

The competition arena is approximately 250' x 500' with natural grass footing. The schooling area is 150' x 300' with natural grass footing.

The Committee reserves the right to prohibit any person from attending or showing a horse and to remove any horse or groom from the Show without being liable for compensation.

The Committee will not be responsible for any accident which may occur to any rider, driver, trainer, groom or attendant, animal, carriage or equipment at the Show.

Should any questions or disputes arise that are not provided for in the rules, the same will be referred to the Show Committee whose decision shall be final.

Bio Hazardous Medical Waste Containers will be provided in the stable area. All exhibitors and their agents are responsible for the proper disposal of this waste.

### **PLEASE NOTE**

Upholding the welfare of the horses being exhibited in the Evergreen Invitational and JR/AO Jumper is of primary concern to the Evergreen management team. We require that all horses be treated with the kindness, respect and compassion they deserve and should never be subjected to mistreatment. Exhibitors, owners, trainers and grooms, or their agents, must use reasonable care in the handling and treatment of the horses owned by them or placed in their care for competition or any other purpose.

We will provide for the continuous well being of the horse by vigorously enforcing the rules of USEF which pertain to the welfare of the horse. Exhibitors are cautioned that ART. 839 will be narrowly interpreted. Violators will be automatically penalized by the elimination of the horse involved from the class in which it is participating. All such violations will be recorded in the Steward's report and reviewed by the Hearing Committee for such action as may be deemed appropriate.

### **REFUNDS**

Horses entered may be scratched without a veterinarian certificate, by written notice to the show secretary (letter, telegram, official scratch sheet, etc.) RECEIVED AT LEAST 3 DAYS PRIOR TO THE BEGINNING OF THE SECTION IN WHICH THE HORSE HAS BEEN ENTERED. When valid notification is received, the entry fee will be refunded, less a \$50.00 scratch fee. Should a horse suffer a severe injury within 3 days of the beginning of the section in which the horse has been entered and be deemed unable to show by the Horse Show Veterinarian, this 3 day notice may be waived. Refunds will be mailed within 30 days after the completion of the show.

### **PRIZE MONEY**

All prize money will be paid through the show office to the owner of record unless specified otherwise. Checks will be available to exhibitors upon completion of last class. Every exhibitor must furnish his/her social security or Federal I.D. number or be subject to IRS withholding of 30%

## **LIABILITY**

The committee will not be liable for any accident which may occur to any rider, trainer, groom, or attendant, animal or equipment at the Show. Should any questions arise that are not provided for in the rules, the issue will be referred to the Organizing Committee whose decision shall be final.

All owners and competitors are personally responsible for damages to third parties caused by themselves, their employees, their agents or their horses. They are therefore strongly advised to take out third-party insurance providing full coverage for participation in equestrian events at home and abroad, and to keep the policy up to date.

In accordance with GR1301.7: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

## **POLING**

Manual Poling and/or the use of bamboo pole offsets are prohibited. Any rider or trainer who is found poling or using offsets, as well as the horse or pony involved, will be immediately eliminated from the show, and will forfeit all entry fees.

## **ATTIRE**

The Organizing Committee requires that all participants be formally attired. ASTM/SEI approved helmets must be worn by all riders when jumping anywhere on the competition grounds. ASTM/SEI approved headgear must be worn by all juniors riding anywhere on the grounds.

## **STABLING**

Stalls will be available starting Thursday, September 9th at 8:00 a.m. **All horses must be on the grounds by 9:00am, Friday, September 10th.** Stalls will be 10 x 10 vinyl with doors, under permanent roof. Shavings and straw will be available for purchase on the grounds. Pre-orders of bedding and any special stabling request may be made with Kate Gerald 847-224-3854.

## **COGGINS**

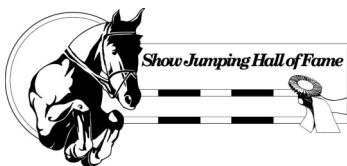
All horses stabled at Evergreen Farm must show proof of a current negative Coggins.

## **SCHOOLING/LUNGEING**

Schooling and lungeing may only be done in designated areas during scheduled times.

## **DOGS**

Dogs will not be permitted on the premises unless restrained on a leash. Stable dogs must be confined at all times. Any owner of a dog found loose in a Show Ring during a competition will be fined \$50.00 and be responsible for the entry fee(s) of the horse(s) whose performance(s) may be disrupted.



## **Cavalor Show Jumping Hall of Fame Junior/Amateur-Owner Jumper Classic Series**

The Cavalor Show Jumping Hall of Fame Jumper Classic Series is designed to give amateur-owner and junior riders an opportunity to compete at higher levels and serves as a proving ground for many riders who aspire to someday represent the United States in international competition.

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Any horse show offering a class that meets all the criteria set forth in the Series specifications and has prize money of at least \$1,000 is eligible to be part of the Series.

Turn right (north) and continue two miles to first stop sign, State Line Road.

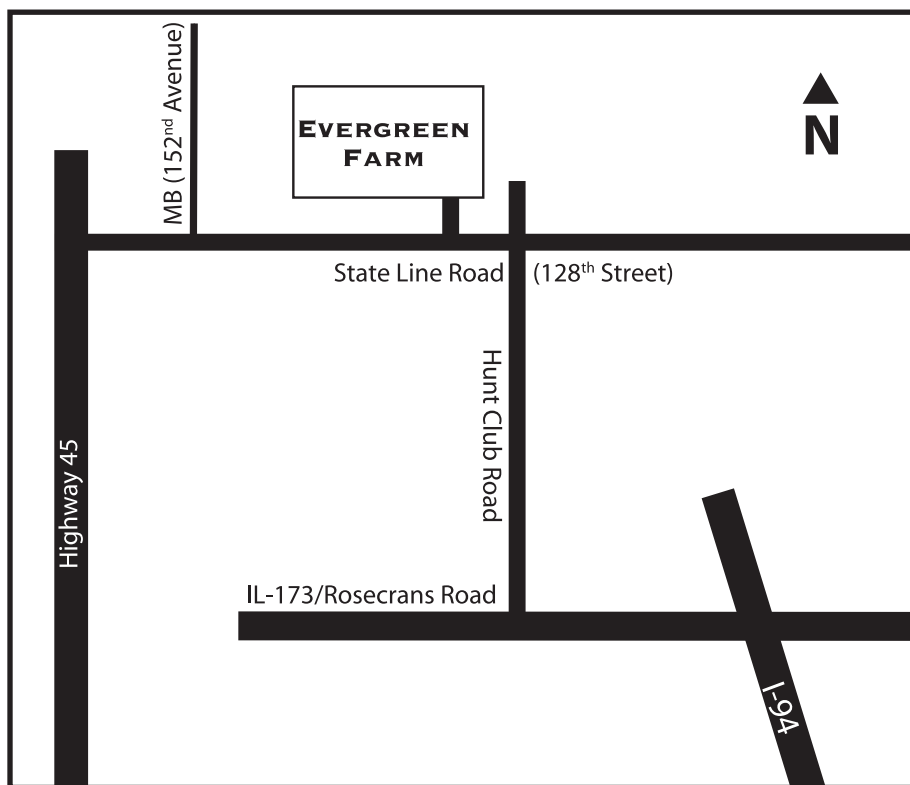
Turn left (west) and go one mile to MB (152nd Avenue).
